Tracking Outcomes

- FOTO: Trevor Staples
 - Used PSFS but hard with translator
 - PROMIS worked well, with REDCAP and record scores
 - Outcome measure on the national level- FOTO
 - Offering to provide access for free to anyone in Pro Bono Network
 - University of Utah directs how to use it
 - Will give access to anyone who needs or wants outcomes
 - Allows us all to have a uniform measure to compare between clinics
 - Exposes students to outcomes early, helps with patient care to see if our interventions actually work
 - March will have training developed and start offering at the Eastern Conference
 - Pt reported outcome measure: shorter number of questions and predict a score of their functional level, length of stay according to demographics
 - Physical function levels, demographic records
 - Translates to English, Spanish, and French
 - PROMIS is a secondary measure to FOTO but only in English
 - Initially start with outpatient orthopedics and PT based
 - Look into future access for neuro, other professions??
 - Promotion through the steering committee
 - Want to: demonstrate that its implementable, compare Pro Bono data to Health Network data
- National Outcomes Registry: Ciara Burgi
 - Move Together- increase access to quality services around the corner and the world
 - Sending survey to pro bono clinics in the US and get basic info
 - New IEs, clients, students, licensed professionals, savings based on Medicare
 - Use this to inform policy and what we are doing
 - Need to readdress the contact list and possibly better or more questions?
 - More of a response rate
 - Mentoring network to show how people to collect outcomes if they want to do that
 - Emails are sent quarterly
 - Can respond to just that quarter or an entire year with their outcomes
 - Maybe better to send it out yearly to get responses?
 - Quarterly emails sent out as reminders?
 - Quarterly emails and people respond when their clinic's year is over?
 - Working with faculty consortia to see who are we advocating TO?

- Use it as a way to compare how your clinic is comparing to the national average?
- Pro Bono Incubator
 - Grant applications opening shortly
 - Requirements: have an innovation want to impose and a Pro Bono service in the US
 - Needs to be a sustainable project

EMR Systems

- John Nellet
 - Started through needing an interprofessional EMR system
 - Billing Dynamix used by St Ambrose and University Mexico
 - Offers it for free as long as you give a monthly blog about rehab services
 - Offers it \$99 to not give a blog post
 - Posed to us to create a universal Pro Bono clinic template
 - Hard because every clinic has their own model
 - Having us all on the same EMR can make tracking outcomes across the Pro Bono Network easier
 - Ultimate goal is for them to be our universal template
 - Up to 8 universities that meet on a monthly basis to discuss what can be changed, what things that work well, etc.
 - They have worked hard to try and accommodate our needs
 - Push to have more Pro Bono Networks?
 - Opportunity to schedule and write notes
 - Subsections for each discipline
 - Everything stored on their server
 - Use laptops and google chrome
 - Use encrypted wifi
 - Do they have sufficient cyber security??
 - Can we embed FOTO or PROMIS outcomes into it?
- Practice Fusion is costly now to practices, even Pro Bono
 - Member to NAFCC(National Association for Free and Charitable Clinics) and get it for free?
